<i>Abstract</i>	This collection contains videos collected by NHS staff as part of the 2021-2022 initiative 'History in the Making.' This initiative seeks to document present-day developments and tensions as a way of connecting the future the past. Since the Newport Historical Society was established in 1854, collecting objects and documents relating to important moments has been central to their mission. It's therefore a natural transition for the Society to document the here and now for future researchers.

Scope and Content

This collection is comprised of digital video files produced by the Newport Historical Society. The first recording of the collection is an interview with Senator Sheldon Whitehouse which documents his account of the storming of the US Capitol on January 6, 2021.
