approximately 70 linear feet; ~92 glass plate negative storage boxes (circa 1890-1930)-approximately 26 linear feet; one banker's box of printing

paraphernalia- one linear foot.

Scope and Content

This collection contains the Newport Daily News Image Archive, which spans from the 1890s to 2000. The collection contains glass plate negatives (1890s-1930s) organized by subject, and photographic negatives (1950-2000), organized by date. The collection also contains various printing paraphernalia used by the newspaper in the printing process, including a masthead printing block, printing blocks for graphics and advertisements, metal printing templates, and a printing mallet.
